Speaker Bios

David A. Asch, MD, MBA, is Executive Director of the University of Pennsylvania Medicine Center for Health Care Innovation, a program that spans the University of Pennsylvania Health System and the Perelman School of Medicine and aims to advance their missions through the disciplined creation, evaluation, and implementation of change. Dr. Asch's research aims to understand and improve how physicians and patients make medical choices in clinical, financial, and ethically charged settings, including the adoption of new pharmaceuticals or medical technologies, the purchase of insurance, and personal health behaviors. His research combines elements of economic analysis with moral and psychological theory and marketing. He teaches health policy at the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania and he practices internal medicine at the Philadelphia Veterans Affairs Medical Center.

Ran D. Balicer, MD, MPH, PhD, is a public health physician, manager and researcher, serves as Director of Health Policy Planning for Clalit – Israel's largest health care organization, and is Founding Director of the Clalit Research Institute – the WHO Collaborating Centre on Noncommunicable Disease Research, Prevention and Control. He is responsible for strategic planning and development of innovative organization-wide interventions for improving health care quality, reducing disparities and increasing effectiveness and care integration, including the introduction of novel data-driven tools into practice. He currently serves as Professor and Track Director in the MPH programme at Ben-Gurion University.
